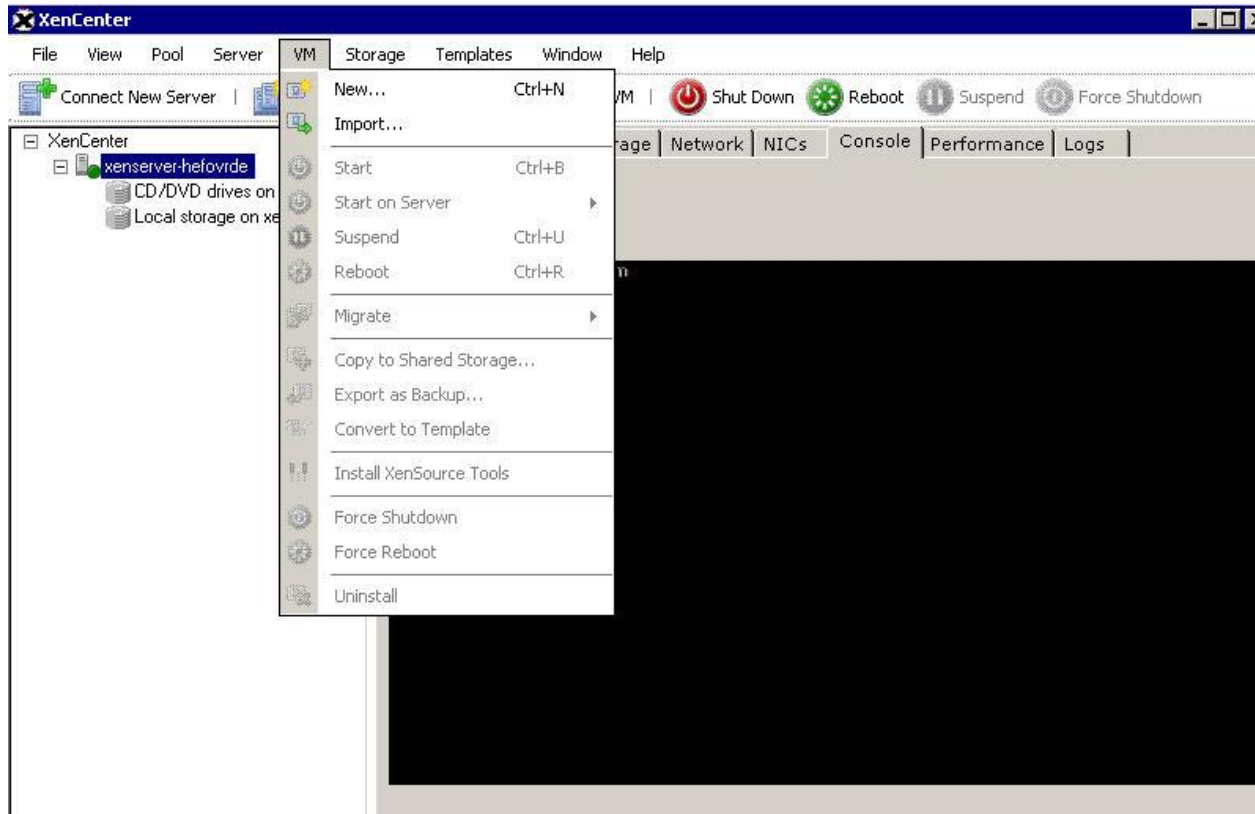

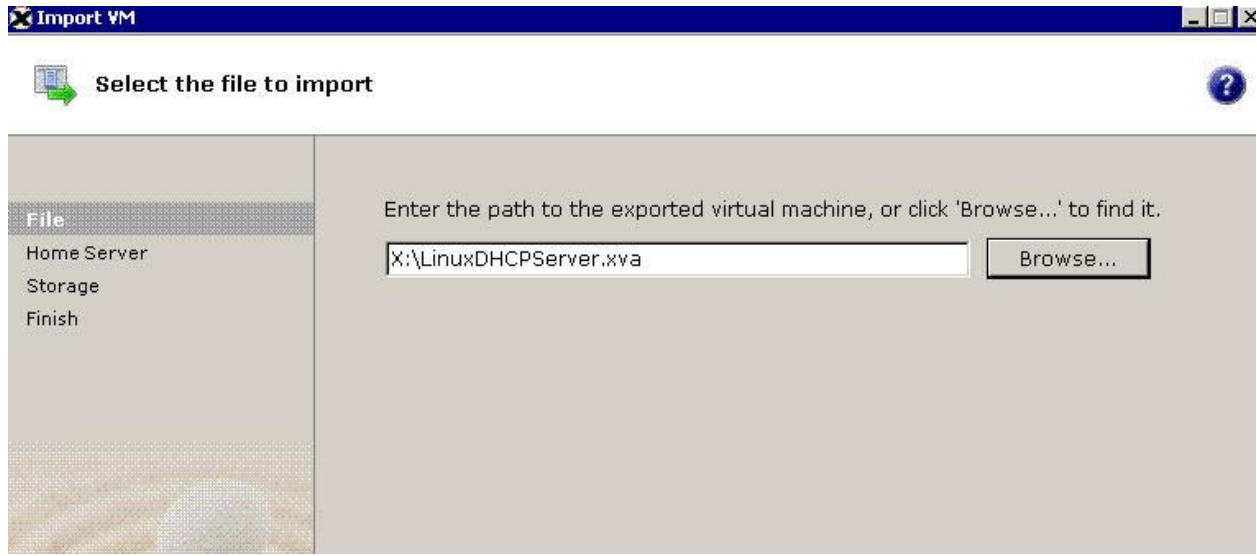

## How to Import Virtual Machines in XenEnterprise

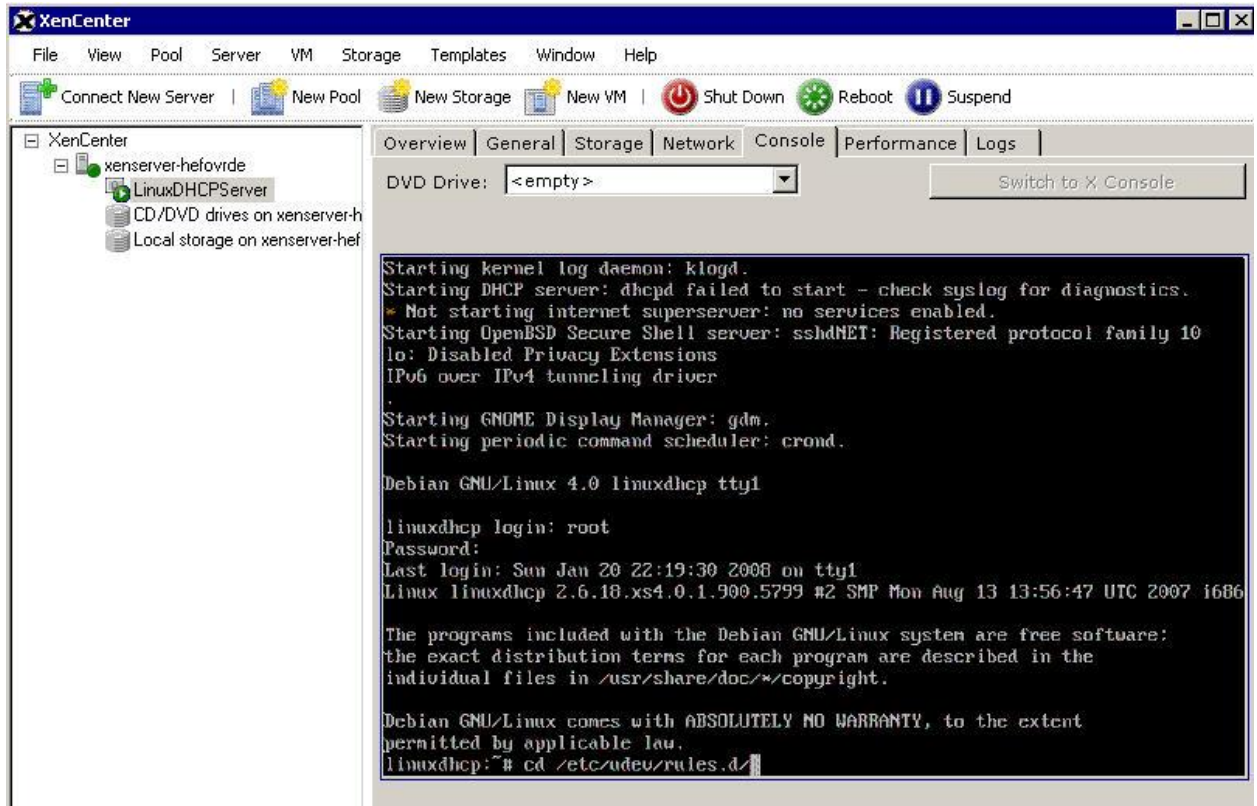
1. The first step to importing Virtual Machines in XenEnterprise, from XenCenter, select **VM** from the menu and **Import**.



2. Select the location of the exported VM from XenCenter. Finish the wizard using the defaults.



3. Once the VM is imported, it will start automatically if you selected that option on the import options.



4. Depending on the VM, you may need to change the NIC configuration to get the VM to function properly. I have the instructions on how to fix errors on the [virtualizationinformation.com](http://virtualizationinformation.com) site.
